It is played at the local level, but hasn't yet made an impact at the national level. Dr Rajole is the National level handball player and winner of Silver Medal at All India Inter-University Handball competition as well as Gold Medal at State level Handball tournament.

To expand the horizon of the handball game the **free of cost training for school students of the same campus**, under 14, 17 and 19 year was also initiated. The students from rural and tribal background has been taking benefits of this training from 2015-16.


